Rayat Shikshan Sanstha

The Rayat Shikshan Sanstha is a renowned and the largest educational institution in the Asian continent. Its founder, Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, witnessed the plight of impoverished farmers and villagers who were deprived of education andknowledge for generations. To bring about a change in this situation, Mahatma Phule's teaching of education is the only path to transformation deeply resonated with him. Accordingly, he decided to take the initiative of providing education to students in rural areas, which was only available in a few cities in Maharashtra.

To spread the light of knowledge to every household, the Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil was inspired by the teachings of Mahatma Phule and Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaja. On 4th October 1919, he began a boarding school in Kale village in the Satara district, marking the beginning of the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's journey.

They brought together children of all castes and religions in society and imparted education to them to promote self-reliance and social awareness. The principles of education were based on equal opportunity, equality, brotherhood, humanity, self-reliance, and social awareness. Various branches of the institution were established based on these principles by Karmveer Bhaurao Patil, primarily in rural and tribal areas so education became easily accessible to all common people.

Through this tireless effort, the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha has transformed into a large organization with its roots firmly planted in the education sector. In 1994, the organization celebrated its Golden Jubilee, and now it is continuing its journey towards the Centenary celebrations. Today, the organization has expanded its reach to 15 districts of Maharashtra and runs over 670 branches, including 40 colleges, more than 400 high schools, junior colleges, and residential hostels. About College:

Library:

As new courses emerge and the continuous evolution of knowledge across various disciplines becomes indispensable for academic excellence, the library assumes paramount importance in equipping students with the requisite skills and comprehensive understanding.

The library is furnished with a comprehensive collection of reference books, textbooks, periodicals, magazines, and newspapers, catering to a diverse range of subjects. Furthermore, it houses an extensive repository of knowledge, ensuring that students have access to the most up-to-date and relevant information. This valuable resource plays a crucial role in preparing students to thrive in the highly competitive global landscape.

Competitive Exam Guidance Center:

To address the growing demand for competitive examination preparation among students, the Institute established the Competitive Exam Guidance Center. Initially, the center exclusively admitted college bonafide students; however, it later expanded its services to cater to a broader student population.

Under the guidance of the center, students have been preparing for various competitive examinations, such as those about Police constable, PSI, STI, IBPS, MPSC, UPSC, and others. This initiative has significantly contributed to the professional development and career advancement of numerous students. The college library has relevant books available for the current competitive exams, and students can take advantage of them. In addition, the 'Karmaveer Vidya Prabodhini' conducts junior and senior college-level competitive exams,

which can serve as a good practice for the MPSC and UPSC exams. Efforts are made to ensure that students get the most benefit from these exams.

Department of Sports:

Physical and mental fitness is the main objective of physical education. Sports and Physical Education are an integral part of the total education system and the present National Education policy emphasizes the promotion and development of sports and Physical Education. The main function of this department is to promote sports by organizing sports activities at the Inter-Collegiate/ Inter-Zonal/Inter-University level.

Our college students participate in Inter-collegiate sports regularly. To promote sports and health awareness among the students, College teams participate in almost all sports events. Students of this college have been selected to participate in the Pune University team, Maharashtra State and Indian team at Asian and International tournaments and some of them have received sports scholarships awarded by Pune University, UGC and the Government of India.

Medical check-up and consultation centre for students:

Annually, the university implements a comprehensive health initiative for first-year students enrolled in courses like B.A., B. Com., B.Sc., and B.C.A. This mandatory medical check-up ensures the well-being of these students and addresses any potential health concerns at the onset of their academic journey.

In addition to this annual program, the college offers medical check-ups and consultation services tailored to the individual needs of students throughout the academic year. To address health-related complaints that may arise on campus, the institution has established a system for providing free first aid services, thereby ensuring the well-being and safety of its students.

National Service Scheme and N.C.C.:

To promote the all-round development of the personality of the youth and to build their social awareness, our college is actively involved in the National Service Scheme. Every year, the department conducts a seven-day labour camp. Students who complete two years of participation in the National Service Scheme and one labour camp are awarded 10 bonus points in their university exams. The college also has a National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) unit that provides students with leadership, discipline, and physical fitness opportunities.

Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil 'Earn and learn' scheme:

In an endeavor to alleviate the financial burdens faced by underprivileged students and ensure they receive a quality education, Karmveer Bhaurao initiated the "Earn and Learn" program under the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha. This innovative initiative aims to provide students with an opportunity to generate income while pursuing their academic goals. The program has been successfully implemented in numerous educational institutions, including our esteemed college.

Eligible and deserving students are selected for the "Earn and Learn" program, wherein they contribute to the college's operations through various tasks. In return, they receive a suitable remuneration that can be utilized for their continued higher education. To further enhance the program's accessibility and support, financial assistance is extended by the affiliated university. As a result, numerous students have benefited from this program, enabling them to overcome financial constraints and focus on their academic pursuits.

Internet facilities:

In the contemporary era of information technology, our institution has taken proactive measures to ensure that relevant information is readily accessible to students. To achieve this goal, internet facilities have been meticulously installed in the college library and across various departments. These resources are made available to students and departments according to their specific requirements, thereby facilitating seamless access to crucial information. This initiative significantly enhances the learning experience and fosters a technologically advanced educational environment within our institution.

Complain Box:

To address student concerns and ensure their well-being, our institution has established complaint boxes in strategic locations, such as the library and within each wing. These boxes serve as a platform for students to voice their grievances and suggestions. Upon review by the designated authorities, the complaints are addressed in a timely and appropriate manner. This

initiative demonstrates our commitment to fostering an open and responsive environment, where students feel heard and supported in their academic pursuits.

Short-term courses:

To enhance the overall educational experience and skill development of our students, our institution offers a diverse range of short-term courses spanning three years. These courses are meticulously designed to impart essential skills in various domains, catering to both self-employment and employment opportunities. We encourage students to collaborate with their respective department heads to explore and secure admission to these courses, ensuring they align with their preferred or related subjects. This initiative fosters holistic growth and equips students with the necessary skills to excel in their chosen career paths.

Placement Cell:

With the growth of industrial and information technology sectors in the Pune area, there is now an increasing demand for skilled human resources from various companies. In this regard, the college has already signed agreements with several companies/organizations. As per the agreement, representatives from the companies visit the campus and conduct interviews of the final year students, selecting suitable candidates, especially for the last year students.

Information regarding college uniforms:

Every student enrolled in the arts, commerce, and science branches of the college must wear the college uniform. The color of the uniform is different for each branch. Detailed information about the uniform will be posted on the notice board of the college.

Identity Card:

It is necessary for every student who has enrolled in this college to have an identification card. Without the ID card, they will not be able to use the library or other facilities. To obtain an ID card, the student must pay the required fee at the library, and they will receive their ID card after payment. Upon receiving the ID card, the student must affix a passport-sized photograph to the card and fill in the necessary information and signatures. Previous year students should renew their ID cards within the given time frame. The ID card must be worn at all times while on the college premises. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action.

Anti-Ragging:

After the Supreme Court directed to put an end to ragging, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has formulated regulations to prevent ragging. Every student and parent must sign a pledge stating that they will not engage in ragging. If any student is found involved in ragging, they will be penalized, including being expelled from allacademic benefits for the entire academic year, withholding of scholarships, fellowships, orany other similar benefits,

debarring from appearing in any test/examination, withholding of results, suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess, rustication from the institution, and imposing a fine of Rs. 25,000 to Rs. 1 lakh. The Anti-Ragging Committee is working actively in universities.

Tip: Admission to the university is only possible if a pledge on a Rs. 10 Bond stating that the student will not engage in ragging is signed, and if not signed, they will not be admitted.

Mobile phones:

Students are prohibited from carrying mobile phones to the classroom. It is a punishable offence under the law to carry mobile phones to class.

T.C. / L.C. / Bonafide:

To apply for a T.C. (Transfer Certificate), admission, or any other official work in Senior College or Junior College, students should submit a prescribed application along with required documents and photocopies and pay the necessary fees between 10:30 am to 1:30pm. After completing the T.C. / admission application process and submitting the necessaryfees, it will be provided to the students.



Information for all:

- 1. All students who are liable to pay the fees, must pay all fees at the time of admission.
- 2. Except for the tuition fee, no other fee will be refunded if admission is cancelled for any reason.
- 3. If admission is cancelled for any reason during the academic year, the student who isa scholarship holder or a fee concession holder will still have to pay the fees, which may be charged as arrears. No fee concession or scholarship will be given to a student who withdraws from the course after admission is cancelled.
- 4. Apart from the above fees, the University shall be free to charge fees for examinations, annual examinations, environment science examinations, etc.
- 5. Other fees will be charged as follows, in addition to regular fees.
- 6. All students who are admitted will have to fill out the examination form at the same time, and the students must appear for the examination at the time determined by the University.

Admission related information:

Once the results of the previous year are declared in this college, the admission process for the next year begins. To take admission, students have to fill out a prescribed admission form. After that, a list of selected candidates is displayed on the notice board and the students are given a specific time frame to take admission. During the admission process, all the rules and regulations of the government are considered. The children of ex-servicemen, disabled children, etc. are also given priority during the admission process. After submitting the admission form, the students need to stay in touch with the admission committee until the admission process is completed. It is also necessary to regularly check the noticeboard for updates. Admission will not be given to students who fail to take admission within the given time frame.

Note: Fill out the admission form without any errors. After filling out the form, get it verified by the admission committee and then fill out the online admission form on the website https://aacm.rayatedu.in Take a printout of the online admission form along with all the necessary documents and get it verified by the college. On the same day, pay the admission fee to confirm your admission.

Rules for all the students taking admission in the college:

- 1. The admission fee once paid by the students will not be refunded for any reason.
- 2. After being admitted in the college, if a student wants to cancel his/her admission from the college, then he/she will have to pay the complete fee for the first semester.
- 3. The fee should be paid at the time mentioned in the information sheet.
- 4. The right to give admission to the college or not is reserved with the Principal.
- 5. For special subjects with limited seats, admission will be given based on merit.
- 6. It is mandatory to take the identification card after admission. Two passport-sized photos in postal ticket size should be submitted to the library for the identification card.

1. First year of Arts, Science, Commerce and B.B.A. programs:

To take admission in the first year of the degree, a student must pass the state board's recognized H.S.C. examination or an examination equivalent to the same.

The students must fulfil the requirements mentioned in the application form while applying for admission. Here is the list of required documents:

- 1. Completely filled and accurate application form along with necessary information.
- 2. Original and photocopy of the leaving certificate from the school or college.
- 3. Eligibility form (completely filled) along with the fee of Rs. 100/- to be sent to the university.
- 4. Complete the fee for the admission form along with the necessary documents.
- 5. Original mark sheet of the 12th standard with two photocopies.

2. Second and Third year of Arts, Science and Commerce:

To take admission in the second and third year of Arts, Science and Commerce programs, students must fulfil the following requirements:

- 1. The application form should be filled out and accurate.
- 2. The previous examination mark sheet should be submitted for verification.
- 3. Complete the fee for the admission form along with the necessary documents.

3. Students transferring to the college from any college under Savitribai Phule Pune University:

- 1. The application form should be completely filled and accurate.
- 2. The Transference Certificate (T.C.) provided by the previous college, until the submission of the T.C. student's admission will be considered provisional.
- 3. The original and true copy of the previous exam's marksheet should be verified bythe authorities.
- 4. The full fee should be paid according to the state application.
- 5. The previous college's academic performance certificate should be attached to the application.

4. Students transferring to the college from other than Savitribai Phule PuneUniversity:

- 1. The admission application along with the information form should be completely and accurately filled in capital letters.
- 2. The original and true copies of the previous exam certificates should be attested.
- 3. The migration certificate from the university is necessary.
- 4. The eligibility form along with a fee of Rs. 100/- for students coming from other universities in the state and Rs. 200/- for students coming from universities outside the state should be submitted.
- 5. The entire fee should be paid as per the admission application fee schedule.
- 6. A certificate indicating the conduct of the previous university should be submitted.

The students who were enrolled in this college in the previous year should be admitted within eight days from the declaration of results of the college's exams, along with completing all the requirements.

Important note: For students of S.Y (B.A./B.Com./B.Sc.) programs, Pune University has included the subject "Environment Awareness" in the curriculum, and every regular student must pass the examination and complete the project related to it to be eligible for a degree. Please make a note of this.


