Student's Feedback Report - 2023-24

The feedback committee of the college takes the feedback from the students for the overall development of the college. In the academic year 2023-2024 the feedback from students about the evaluation of college was taken by using 4 point scale. The students of college upload their feedback through the Google form link provided to them. Students noted some suggestions about the overall development of college. These are - need of more books in library, organizing parent's meet on regular basis, use of digital reference classroom, increasing number of instruments / equipment in laboratory, use of more innovative teaching methods, increasing placement drives, recruitment of regular teachers. The students are satisfied with the university syllabus as they find the relevance of present syllabus with current and applied contents. All the teaching faculty delivered their regular lectures with full preparation and also they are able to communicate with students in effective manner. Sincere effort were taken by the teachers for conducting their continuous internal evaluation process which includes Units tests, Tutorials, Home assignment, Midterm examination, Seminar, Group Discussion, Open Book Test in addition to the regular University examination for each class as per assigned schedule . The institute has been taken active interest in promoting internship, training programmes, field project for the B.Voc courses, The industrial trips, field visit, Institutional visits are regularly organized for each interests and job opportunities for students. The college department to offer learning established the Mentor - Mentee scheme as institutional best practices for the student's academic, social and emotional growth. The students are guided rightly on their overall performance and difficulties. Teachers built up the expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes among the students. The teacher do the SWOT analysis of the students and guide them as per their needs. Teachers are able to identify the strengths and weakness of students and encourage and guide respectively and prepare them by providing right level of challenges.

The college has different committees for the effective working in Academic, Curricular, Extracurricular and Extension activity. Each committee attracts the students towards extracurricular activities and take care to engage students in participating various activities of the college. A few students have been suggested to strengthen and inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills among the students. The college runs add-on courses and various certificate courses like Talley, Mobile repairing, accounting, sericulture etc. to ensure the skill and employability among students. Most of teachers are using ICT tools




